#### **Pet Policies**

Tide Mill Apartments is a pet friendly community, and we always welcome new pets! However, we do require our residents to report any new pets they acquire during their residency.

Per the lease agreement, should an unregistered pet be found in an apartment, the resident will be fined \$100 and will be required to either remove the pet or register the pet with the office within 3 days, otherwise a \$25 fee per day will be assessed after the 3 day allotment.

In addition to the fines, the resident will also be responsible for paying the onetime pet registration fee of \$250 and a monthly pet rent of \$25 per pet.

Please be sure to register your pet with the office to avoid any additional fees. We certainly do not wish for our residents to pay unnecessary fines.
